Community Improvement



In 2023, the Mangalagiri site staff have partnered with Chalice to construct houses for 15 selected families in the Amaravathi and Khammam communities. There are 52 people among them, including 28 children, and an average of three to four members per household. More than half of the parents rely on daily labour work, and nine families are headed by women.

Goal

15 families will have a safe house for themselves to live in with dignity and self-worth.

Objectives

- To provide financial and technical assistance to construct houses for 15 families.
- To monitor the work, progress and completion of the house construction by six months.
