



## 2017-2018 Annual Report: Amanecer Site Amanecer Religious Foundation Bolivia, Latin America

The "Amanecer" Religious Foundation focuses its priority attention to a population at high social risk and on the street, of children and adolescents who for various reasons abandon their family and are separated from public authorities. When this population is embraced in the houses of the institution, they receive care, protection and comprehensive training. They also receive attention and promotion of the external families in a situation of poverty and vulnerability, with the purpose of strengthening the family bond and this way preventing total or partial home abandonment from their children.

### Education

#### *Achievements*

1. El 100% of the population in the different homes are enrolled in the school system, 10% achieved an outstanding school performance.
2. All residents have been provided with school material according to their needs and school requirements.
3. Two sponsored young ladies completed their high school education, three scholar by Banco Mercantil Bank Santa Cruz and Chalice, concluded their professional training in the career of Management and Entrepreneurship, all with good academic performance.



#### *Goals*

1. Access and permanence in the educational system of children and young people, internal and external, with an optimum academic level.
2. Achieve that young people access a technical training with the possibility of finding a paid work source and continue their higher education.

### Health & Hygiene

#### *Achievements*

1. All parents who participate in family circles have acquired basic knowledge in Health and Hygiene, 40% of those trained put into practice the health care of their children by applying good hygiene habits in their home.



2. All the children and young people welcomed in Amanecer, put into practice preventive hygiene measures.

### Goals

1. Strengthen knowledge and motivate the application of basic measures of personal and environmental hygiene, handling and recycling of garbage in families.
2. Access health insurance for the school-age population and continue with the health prevention program.
3. Strengthen the self-esteem of interns by preparing them for family reintegration or independence.



### Nutrition

#### Achievements

1. 4 food handlers and 12 adolescents, in the shelters, have knowledge and were trained in the management of a healthy menu and hygiene measures.
2. 80 external families have basic knowledge to prepare a nutritious and healthy diet, protecting their family's health.



### Goals

1. Strengthen internal production and promote occupational therapy by working in the gardens of the shelters, in addition to promoting good nutrition.
2. Intervene in the prevention of oral health by providing access to dental care and timely hygiene material.
3. That families prioritize the purchase of nutritious foods.

### Community

#### Achievements

1. 90% of the families receive their DFF in their bank accounts that allows them to make a good sponsorship money administration.
2. All families received training in health issues, economic and human values that has improved the relationship in the family.
3. 28 strengthened leaders, accompany their family circles, generating active participation, with clear rules established by all members.





### Goals

1. That family circles succeed in improving the sustainability of their organization.
2. To have the support of organizations and institutions that allow participation activities among children and adolescents and their families.

### Family

#### Achievements

1. 23 children have been reintegrated thanks to the coordinated work with the street team of the Children's Ombudsman.
2. Strengthened 25 parents in family violence, family disintegration, communication, role of parents in the formation of their children and social support in cases that require it.



### Goals

1. Establish family unity where one can experience human and Christian values through formation in evangelical values in family circles.
2. Promote that the families take responsibility in their functions of support and upbringing of their children.

### Direct Family Financing / Chalice Family Circles

#### Achievements

1. 14 family circles assume with greater responsibility the administration of their sponsorship.
2. In addition to having in this year 7 family circles and 2 groups of independent young people; 5 circles were formed strengthening community and family work.

### Goals

1. That families prioritize the promotion and education of their children through a good administration of the financial aid received from the DFF.
2. That families administer the funds received from the DFF in a transparent manner.
