



## Annual Report 2017-2018: Site Fatima Uyariy Foundation Bolivia, Latin America

The **Site Fatima** works with children and adolescents from families at risk and with many social and economic problems, while the **Sub-Site Emaus** supports adults over 65 in vulnerable situation, due to family abandonment and extreme poverty.

### Education

#### *Achievements*

1. 100% of sponsored children and adolescents are studying with a very good school performance. In the steps taken, 20 young people finished the baccalaureate.
2. At present, we have 7 students who are in the university and two scholars who study in the city of La Paz in the Catholic University, thanks to Hope of my Future program.
3. 100% of seniors request the products they need and express their feelings through letters or drawings.



#### *Goals*

1. Avoid school dropout and keep 100% of children and adolescents enrolled, supporting those with learning problems.
2. Enlarge the participation of students in the application for the Study Scholarship "A hope for my future" that Chalice, "Banco Mercantil Santa Cruz" and "Universidad Católica" finance.

### Health & Hygiene

#### *Achievements*

1. 70% of children and seniors are aware about the importance of the prevention of health, thanks to the talks of the team.
2. With sponsorship funds, Special Money and Grant, all beneficiaries give priority to the purchase of personal hygiene supplies.
3. The immune system of all seniors has been strengthened, through the delivery of vitamins and / or nutritional products, thus contributing to the prevention of common diseases of their age.



### Goals

1. Keep supporting preventive health and provide medicines to prevent diseases in children and seniors.
2. Implement sexual and reproductive health workshops, thus contributing to the reduction of teenage pregnancy.

### Nutrition

#### Achievements

1. 70% of families give priority to the purchase of nutritious products for the preparation of their food.
2. 70 children under 5 years of age, from the Sacred Heart of Jesus Children's Center, improved their diet thanks to the distribution of breakfast, snacks and lunch through the Chalice Children program.
3. 100% of sponsored seniors consume food appropriate to their age, avoiding refined sugar and giving priority to the purchase of fish with their sponsorship funds.



### Goals

1. Ensure that 100% of parents give priority to the purchase of nutritious and healthy food for their families.
2. Carry out height and weight controls twice a year to each child and senior to prevent health problems.

### Family

#### Achievements

1. Participation increased by 15% of parents (men) of sponsored children and 30% of children or guardians of seniors in general meetings.
2. 10 % of young people take the responsibility for managing their resources and participating in scheduled meetings





3. 10 % of the parents (men) were integrated into the housework supporting their wives when they go out to work.

#### Goals

1. Promote training of parents for them to implement small businesses that allow them to improve their quality of life.
2. Strengthen the organization "Escuela para Padres" in coordination with the Parish.

#### Community

#### Achievements

1. We have updated and permanent academic information of the sponsored ones, thanks to the close relationship with the educational units.
2. The parish remains a recognized benchmark in the execution of social projects in the area.
3. The closing of the children's center "Sagrado Corazón de Jesús" has been avoided.



#### Goals

1. Consolidate and legalize the documentation of the first Association of Seniors "EMAÚS" in the South Zone.
2. Support the "Sagrado Corazon de Jesús" Children's Center, social work of the "Virgen de Fátima".

#### Direct Family Funding

#### Achievements

1. It has been possible to maintain 23 Family Circles working under the DFF system and 9 Working Groups for Seniors, which already have an internal organization.
2. 60 mothers of family are trained in baking and weaving, with the possibility of implementing micro-enterprises.
3. 80 fathers and mothers are trained in: financial education and family savings.

#### Goals

1. Increase participation of families in workshops and trainings, promoting good administration of their sponsorship funds as part of the family budget and motivating individual and group savings.
2. Promote small projects or family enterprises to improve their social and economic situation.
