✚ Education

Achievements

1. Children and adolescents have space for support and leveling, as well as other advice and motivation to pursue future studies at a technical or undergraduate level.
2. In the Pacata Sub-site, 90 children and adolescents benefited, for the first time, with the implementation of the School Support Program
3. Through the DFF program, children and adolescents received school supplies and support in the form of payment of monthly fees for their studies in institutes and others.

Goals

1. Implement the human development program for school support, with the permanent presence of an educator and the provision of refreshments to those who participate.
2. Raise awareness among parents about the importance of accompanying their children in the educational process and prioritizing the purchase of school supplies.

✚ Health & Hygiene

Achievements

1. At least 50 sponsored children and adolescents received medical attention in health centers and hospitals, as a result of inter-institutional coordination. 35 children were benefited with the delivery of glasses, thanks to the coordination of the site with the Kantutani Foundation.
2. All sub-sites have a medicine kit for emergency cases.
3. 150 children and adolescents strengthened their personal hygiene habits and cleanliness of environments.

Goals

1. Guide families on the importance of hygiene and health.
2. Promote health campaigns, with contribution of medical centers and hospitals.

Nutrition

Achievements

1. 70 children and adolescents benefited from complementary food.
2. 80 children and adolescents benefited with complete lunches, thanks to Chalice programs and contributions from the parish.
3. Engaged participation of parents in the preparation of food.

Goals

1. Help families in the purchase of food for the preparation of healthy and nutritious food.
2. Strengthen the knowledge of mothers to improve the nutritional conditions of families, mainly sponsored and non-sponsored children and adolescents.

Community

Achievements

1. 40 children were trained in leadership topics, thanks to the coordination made by the Site with the Map International NGO.
2. 20 cases, including child abuse, family assistance and labor exploitation, were referred to the ombudsmen, thanks to the close coordination with the Site.
3. 45 children and adolescents were part of their first holy communion and confirmation, motivated by family visits and family circle meetings.

Goals

1. Strengthen relationships between family circles and the community.
2. Support parishes so they can provide social services to the population.

Family

Achievements

1. 50% of families actively participated in workshops and program activities.
2. 30% of sponsored children and adolescents were integrated into pastoral life.
3. The personnel of the sub-site are reference points of support and confidence of the children, adolescents and young people of the communities in the search of solution to their problems.

Goals

1. Train families on the importance of accompanying their children.
2. Strengthen family ties.

Direct Family Financing /Chalice Family Circles

Achievements

1. 99% of the population opened personal savings accounts.
2. 40 of 55 families have strengthened bonds of trust and support amongst its members.
3. 90% of Family Circles assume their responsibilities, roles and activities in an appropriate manner.
