

# Annual Report, 2018: Berhampur Site

Diocese of Berhampur; Odisha, India

## Education:

### *Accomplishments:*

1. Out of the 59 students appeared in the Matriculation examination, 48 students got through in the examination and will enrol in 11<sup>th</sup> grade and the remaining 11 will reappear in the examination for which they are in special coaching classes. 16 students appeared for the higher secondary final examinations and 13 of them were promoted and the remaining 3 will reappear. 4 appeared in graduation and 4 of them passed.
2. Children were provided with learning materials, school bags, school fees etc through DFF.
3. The solar system in Birikote convent and bore well in Aliganda boys' hostel are great support for the children.
4. Special coaching facilities for weaker children for all subjects are arranged in all the hostels.

### *Goals:*

1. To reemphasize the value of education to the children up to grade 9.
2. To give orientation on career guidance to the students of grade 10 and above.



## Nutrition:

### *Accomplishments:*

1. All boarding children are paid mess fees through Direct Family fund (DFF)
2. Food for all boarding children is provided as per the menu prepared by the dietician.
3. Children of all boarding are encouraged to work one hour in the garden, cultivating vegetables and keep the surrounding clean. This helps them to get fresh food and also their physical exercise is met.
4. There is regular game for the hostel children. For the boys Volley Ball, foot ball, kabadi, kho kho and cricket and for the girls there are different games like skipping rope, ring ball, kabadi, kho kho etc. are organised.

### *Goals:*

1. Quality and quantity of the food provided is to be monitored regularly.
2. Nutrition provided to the old leprosy patients from the grant fund.

## Health & Hygiene:

### Accomplishments:

1. Children are provided toiletries like tooth paste, brush, soaps, oil etc. regularly to keep themselves clean and healthy
2. Provided good drinking water.
3. Leprosy patients are provided medicines and dressing from the grant fund in every quarter.
4. 451 children attended health camps in Birikote, Raipanka and Berhampur.

### Goals:

1. Health camp will be conducted for all the sponsored children at 3 different places such as in Raipanka, Birikote and in Berhampur. Professionals in the field of health will be invited to this camp.
2. Health record for each sponsor child will be maintained.



## Community:

### Accomplishments:

1. All the sponsored children are in DFF.
2. Orientation programme was conducted for 150 members on Chalice trust fund for all the 6 Subsites.
3. Community and family development also is taken care CCGs. Occupational activities are increased, utensils and tent is provided for some groups for the income generation.
4. Petty shops are provided for the business and earning purpose.
5. Other siblings of the sponsored children also are being helped.

### Goals:

1. Inculcate the habit of saving among the people.
2. Instil the sense of employment to the village people.

## Direct Family Funding/ Circle Groups:

### Accomplishments:

1. 52 Chalice Circle groups are existing at present.

2. 150 office bearers of Chalice Circle Groups were given orientation on trust fund.
3. 52 trust fund account has been opened and at work.
4. Taking loan from the CCG groups are introduced.

*Goals:*

1. To monitor the DFF account and CCGs.
2. To monitor the CCG regarding Chalice Trust Fund.

**Orientation programs: / Annual children meet:**

*Accomplishments:*

1. There was different orientation programs conducted in three different places such as child competency program/ Child assessment, education on Adolescent.
2. Children benefited a lot from these programs and from the annual meet.



*Goals:*

1. To grow the children with overall maturity.
2. To have exposure to other field of life apart from their studies.
