



Annual Report 2018: Star Site

South India

The **Star site** works with mentally retarded, physically challenged, HIV/AIDS infected, orphan and semi-orphan children. The families are under below poverty line and they are going for agriculture based daily wages.

1. Education

Accomplishment:

- ❖ Presently 521 are benefitting from Chalice Sponsorship Program. Out of it, 303 are in secondary schools and 97 are in primary schools. 47 students are attending university courses in different Colleges and 20 students attending technical courses and 53 are mentally retarded children and 1 elderly woman.
- ❖ 7 students are pursuing Post Graduate education and 2 children got Job placement.
- ❖ Regular Home visits and School visits reduced the drop outs.



Goals

- ❖ To reduce the dropouts rate
- ❖ To make the children to set their goals and pathways to reach

2. Health and Hygiene

Accomplishment:

- ❖ 175 adolescents learned gender equality, biological and physical changes in their body.
- ❖ All the sponsored children attended health camp and maintain health card.
- ❖ Most of the sponsored families began to use toilet and keep the environment clean.

Goals

- ❖ To monitor and guide the adolescents children continuously.
- ❖ To make sponsored children and families to live in a hygienic and clean surrounding.

2. Nutrition

Accomplishment:

- ❖ All the sponsored children and specially the HIV children are taking proper nutritious food and their health conditions have improved.
- ❖ Parents are began to use the DFF money for Nutritious food for their children
- ❖ Our CCGs are monitoring the usage of money for Nutritious purposes.



Goals

- ❖ To calculate Body Mass Index of each child once in 6 months
- ❖ To educate the sponsored families and their siblings in avoiding taking junk food.



3. Family

Accomplishment:

- ❖ The Sponsored Family members are fully involving and strictly following the guidelines of Chalice Canada.
- ❖ All the Family members have become the member of any one of the CCGs.
- ❖ The family members also learned the habit of savings



Goals

- ❖ To make the parent to spent the sponsored money for children's health and education. Goals
- ❖ To Make the family members in showing concerns to neighbours



4. Direct Family Funding and Chalice Circle Groups:
