



2017-2018 Annual Report: Dominica Site Paraguayan Congregation of the Third Dominican Parish Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Sacrament Paraguay, Latin America

The Dominica Site has been working for more than 10 years with children, young people and the elderly from low-income and vulnerable families.

Education

Achievements

1. 25 young people and adults had access to basic education thanks to the inauguration of Basic School N° 11-432, located within the San Pedro Chapel, dependent of the Ministry of Education and Science.
2. An agreement was signed to support several training programs for fathers, mothers, youth and adolescents in various thematic subjects, between the Dominica Site and the National Service of Professional (SNPP, for its acronym in Spanish).
3. 90% of sponsored children attend school regularly.



Goals

1. Improve the education of children and youth who attend schools.
2. Continue with the sewing and bakery workshops for mothers, fathers and sponsored youth, through agreements with the SNPP.

Health & Hygiene

Achievements

1. Families can access free care in the dental office of the San Pedro Chapel, which has a modern dental chair, radiographic equipment, lighting and comfortable and adequate buildings.
2. 50 families have been trained in personal hygiene.
3. 8 family circles have been trained in topics of prevention of drug addiction and unwanted pregnancies.





Goals

1. Reach agreements with the Ministry of Public Health to have professionals permanently in different areas.
2. Carry out deworming campaigns for Boys and girls and educate them in personal hygiene.

Nutrition

Achievements

1. 160 children have benefited with lunch from Monday to Friday thanks to the Chalice Children program.
2. 12 Family Circles received training on the importance of consumption of nutritious food.
3. 12 mothers and fathers know and apply their knowledge in the adequate preparation of food, thanks to the courses provided by SNPP and the Site.

Goals

1. Generate interest in our community on the subject of good and proper nutrition.
2. Motivate the interest of children and adolescents on the consumption of nutritious foods.

Community

Achievements

1. The Municipality has carried out the improvement of bridges, Parks, fluvial works, paving of main roads and surroundings of the community thanks to the efforts performed by the family circles and the Site.
2. 20 family circles interrelate and support each other.
3. 4 family circles carried out joint activities, using their salaries to celebrate "Children's Day".



Goals

1. Increase the participation of the community in the activities of the Parish.
2. That all family circles become more involved in the activities of the community.

Family

Achievements

1. 50% of families prepared their own Budget prioritizing their basic needs.



2. 20% of parents managed to get a better job thanks to the training, improving their family income.

3. All family members are supportive sharing their income within the family.

Goals

1. Build 20 restrooms for sponsored families, through the Gift Catalogue program.
2. Continue training for CFC.

Direct Family Financing / Chalice Family Circles

Achievements

1. 100% of families have opened their individual savings accounts.
2. 50% of family circles have an account in a bank where they manage their group savings.
3. Thanks to the training done in DFF, the leaders of all the family circles have a proper management and administration of the group funds.

Goals

1. Achieve the integral empowerment of our beneficiaries within family circles.
2. Carry out accompaniment so family circles meet the established goals.
