“World of Children”: Ternopil, Ukraine

Education:

Accomplishments

- 100% of sponsored children attend educational establishment.
- The number of students who have received excellent grade reports has increased from 148 to 201 this year.
- Sponsored children actively participate in various educational contests and competitions.
- 6 gifted children can develop their talents by learn music and arts in Art School owing to sponsorship funds.
- 6 students can cover their tuition fee owing to their sponsorship and site support.
- 219 sponsored children in 6 areas joined bus tours to various locations with educational purposes.
- The site has supported the number of schools attended by the sponsored children. Owing to GCC, 3 classrooms in 2 schools are furnished with new desks and chairs; 1 laptop and 2 printers were supplied to 2community libraries.

Goals

- Encourage more students in getting postsecondary education.
- Educate sponsored children by providing master classes, lectures, trainings, tutoring and tours.

Health & Hygiene:

Accomplishments

- The majority of sponsored children adhere to hygiene regimen owing to sponsorship.
- 1 handicapped child is supported with wheelchair from Critical Needs Funds that allows the single mother take the child out to trainings.
- 2 sponsored children received adequate medical care owing to CN program.
- 29 sponsored children/family members have received adequate medical care owing to support from grants, SM and GCC.
- The Site has supported Pidvolochysk Community Center in equipping a Rehabilitation Room to improve health condition of children with special needs including 17 sponsored.

Goals

- To use Critical Needs Funds for addressing urgent medical issues in children or their family members.
- Organize lectures on maintaining good health and diet by medical professionals.

Nutrition

Accomplishments

- All sponsored children have at least 3 meals a day one owing to their sponsorship and regular balanced food supply.
- 1 family received a cow from GCC for enriched nutrition and income, and 4 families used SM on livestock purchase for better nutrition.
- Many parents of sponsored children stopped buying junk and unhealthy foods after the course of lectures on healthy nutrition arranged by the Site.
- The acquired gas stoves for 3 families of sponsored children as gift from catalogue has resolved the issue of cooking fresh and hot meals fast.

Goals

- To teach the children and their families on healthy nutrition and regimen by involving professionals.
- To arrange master classes for children on cooking and preparing healthy meals.

Community:

Accomplishments

- The Capital Project on roof replacement in Horynka School has been successfully completed.
- The Capital Project on Sports complex reconstruction in Darakhiv School has been successfully completed.
- The site has provided substantial support in replacing 102 windows for energy saving for 2 Community Centers, 6 Schools; 2 libraries and 1 kindergarten.

- In 2 schools and 2 day care centers, indoor toilets have been upgraded to be used by the children.
- The Site has supported 2 Hospitals with urine analyzer and electrocardiograph to make the medical services available for their patients in the area.
- The Site has supported 1 village day care center with furniture to make the stay of the children their comfortable.
- The mothers of the sponsored children have become more proactive, united and involved in various trainings, lectures and conferences. They strive to reveal their potential.

Goals

- To promote progress and development in the Community by meeting the vital needs of schools and children institutions.
- To unite Parent Groups and children from different areas for experience exchange by organizing sport competitions, mutual celebrations and meetings.

Family:

Accomplishments

- Provision of household goods to families of sponsored children improves the quality of their living.
- The living conditions in a number of families of sponsored children have been improved owing to GCC and SM: new windows and doors installed to keep warmer inside, renovated floor, replaced roofs, connecting to water supply to the house, new furniture.
- Owing to GCC, 13 sponsored children have received their own beds to sleep; 7 children – new cozy mattresses; 2 children – desks to study; 3 families – new gas stoves; 2 families – necessary appliances to start their own small business.
- 107 families of sponsored kept warm in cold season owing to fire woods supply from Grants and Critical Needs funds.
- 80 parents of sponsored children have been trained on overcoming conflicts in the family and as a result the family environment and relationships have significantly improved there.
- Psychological counseling for families and sponsored children has helped them resolve various psychological family issues.
- Field workers and parent leaders visit handicapped children at home to greet them on their birthdays.
- Most of the families embrace the Site as their extended family.

Goals

- Continue education and training for parents of the sponsored children on overcoming family conflicts.
- Organize education and training on starting a business for parents of the sponsored children to help them provide for themselves.

Direct Family Funding/ Circle Groups:

Accomplishments

- The number of sponsored children on DFF has doubled receiving sponsorship funds once a quarter on their individual bank accounts.
- Handicapped children on DFF are supplied with diapers to alleviate daily care routine for the family members.
- Parent groups organize different parties and gatherings to celebrate their children’s achievements and award best students with gifts from group savings.

Goals

- To increase the number of Direct Family Funding receivers to 500 sponsored children this year.
- To organize trainings for parents and students on family budgeting and expenses so that funds are managed properly.
