Our site provides special education support to children who are visually impaired and vulnerable from the community through acquisition of life skills in all their study areas. We also work closely with the community by providing projects/programs and financial management skills to parents/guardian of children under Chalice sponsorship.



Education

Goals

1. To offer tuition classes as a way of a holistic education to learners.
2. To instil in our children self confidence and for them to learn that disability is not inability.

Achievements

1. 80 percent of pupils with visual impairment have improved in terms of reading and writing braille.
2. The implementation of extra curricular and debate programs at school has successfully helped the pupils to obtain good results after writing their exams.
3. Counselling sessions have been conducted to learners which have led to 85 percent of learners having sound decisions and improvement in academic performance and behaviour.



Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To procure more health hygiene materials such as sun cream, lotion and disinfectant.
2. To promote personal hygiene programs through health talks done in every quarter of the year.

Achievements

1. The procurement of sun cream for 41 children with albinism was provided and this improved their health standards.
2. Distribution of disinfectant and toiletries to about 120 children was successfully done.
3. Conducted guidance and counselling on health matters and in particular about personal hygiene to all sponsored and non sponsored children at the school.



Nutrition

Goals

1. Procurement of more food for the children.
2. Promotion of self-sustainability through goat keeping so as to provide children with protein for body health.



Achievements

1. Meals were provided and this improved the health of all children in the site.
2. Successful procurement of food was also done.
3. There was supplementation on boarding cost by chicken rearing and gardening.



Community

Goals

1. Organise more workshops/seminars on food security.
2. Promote group farming using modern farming methods and tools.

Achievements

1. Christmas gifts and gift catalogue funds helped various families of the aged and the vulnerable with assorted food and hygiene items.
2. The local community are now enjoying chicken and goat meat from our site at a lower price when compared to the market price.
3. Through provision of various workshops on livestock farming, various families have continued to improve their farming methods therefore improving their food security.



Family

Goals

1. Visit families and sensitize the members on good family relationships.
2. Sensitize families on the importance of their children's education.

Achievements

1. Sensitization on the importance of parent involvement in their children education was conducted during the course of the year.
2. Special money helped some families to buy house furniture for their homes.



Family funding

Goals

1. Talk to the two groups on broadening their knowledge on livestock and modern farming methods.
2. Conduct a workshop on entrepreneurship skills.



Achievements

1. Implementation of goat keeping and chicken rearing projects has helped the parent groups to be self-sustained as they share the profits made.
2. Workshops on the importance of setting goals and implementation were conducted.
3. Unity was noticed among parents during meetings as group members worked together on common farms to improve food security.
