



Our Kumbo sponsor site works with children and youth from high-risk families, with the poor, and with those facing social and economic problems. . We also work with children and adults with disabilities and support the elderly of above 60 years of age in situations of vulnerability and extreme poverty.



Education

Goals

1. To guide children to use their time productively in order to prevent social issues.
2. To help our community understand that education is the key to a better life.

Achievements

1. **60%** of our sponsored children and youth are in school or learning a trade.
2. Advised and assisted some of our families to relocate to the French speaking Cameroon to allow their children to access education during conflicts.
3. Enrolled many of our other sponsored children in community schools organised by parents.

Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To keep our beneficiaries healthy and to teach them that prevention is better than a cure.
2. Host seminars and workshops on the importance of a healthy home environment.

Achievements

1. **96%** of our sponsored children, elderly and their families are registered in the Health Assistant Scheme and benefit regularly when sick.
2. Children, elderly and their families are better aware of the importance of health and hygiene.

Nutrition

Goals

1. To provide feeding programs for the elderly and the sick.
2. To educate families on essential nutrition and the importance of a balanced diet.



Achievements

1. Provided food assistance to elderly and sick beneficiaries.
2. Field workers conducted body weight and height measurements regularly for our sponsored children, and provided additional support to those with low weight.

Community

Goals

1. To build strong and vibrant communities through active FC groups.
2. To keep helping and giving company to the elderly and sick in the community.

Achievements

1. Good community networking was shown by our site when working with others like the Justice and Peace Commission, water committees in our villages, and Nascent Solution NGO.
2. With gift catalogue funds, we were able to provide **10** families with roofing sheets, a borehole for Martins hospital, a solar system for the Sister's residence, a storage room for Kongadzem, a water tank for Shisong village, and animals for group projects.
3. We created awareness in the community that elderly and displaced people are a part of us and have a lot to offer.

Family

Goals

1. To promote solidarity among families and groups.
2. To continue building strong families through projects that will provide a strong community base.



Achievements

1. We observed a good understanding amongst families & groups.
2. Good team spirit was demonstrated when carrying out group projects.

Family funding

Goals

1. To uplift and boost self-esteem of members in family circle groups.
2. To provide programs to our beneficiaries that will lead to better money management.
3. To boost the economic and social empowerment of our groups through seminars and workshops.

Achievements

1. **40** family circles are registered with the Registrar of Societies of Cameroon Republic.
2. Members of family circles own and operate their own bank accounts with our supervision.
3. Members were able to purchase nutritional products for their children with funds.
4. About **20%** of each disbursement was saved by each member to create a group savings account for emergency loans.
