Our site works with needy families residing in the slums in the west part of Mombasa County. The poor state of the families is as a result of the extreme vicious cycle of poverty caused by illiteracy and harmful cultural beliefs. There is increased level of illegal and criminal activities such as drug peddling among the youth from the slums. Sponsored children get to attend school and have their basic needs met.



Education

Goals

1. To maintain 100% of sponsored children in schools and colleges so as to have a smooth transition to various levels of education.
2. To ensure the sponsored children are enrolled in the schools that we partner with and offer feeding programs so the children will no longer have to stay hungry while in school.
3. To strengthen monitoring systems of our sponsored children in the schools around the area of operation and network with other sites to be able to monitor the children that are in secondary and colleges that are away from our area of operation.

Achievements

1. Almost 95% of the sponsored children and youths are in primary, secondary and colleges respectively and are doing well in their studies.
2. Children at Abraham Education Centre and Kipevu Primary School have been trained on good agricultural practices.
3. School attendance has improved significantly due to introduction of feeding programs.
4. Through the gift catalogue, our site has been able to pay school fees for college, secondary and university students for them to be able to finish their education and achieve their goals.



Health & hygiene

Goals

1. Ensure there is increased number of healthy families in the community.
2. Ensure that there is reduced number of chronic diseases amongst the sponsored families.

Achievements

1. Through the feeding program in schools both the attendance, performance and enrollment in the schools has greatly increased.
2. Through the quarterly trainings sponsored families are able to manage lifestyle and chronic diseases.
3. Through Family Funding, sponsored families can now purchase and consume locally available nutritious food.



Nutrition

Goals

1. Continuation of feeding programs through production of clean, good and fair food for pupils.
2. Improve livelihood of the poor in the community by encouraging small scale farming for sustainable food for the families.

Achievements

1. Maize was harvested successfully in Patanane (Kwale) which has helped the school feeding program.
2. There's been passage of knowledge and skills to the pupils in schools and the community members through their formed groups.
3. Improved water storage in schools through provision of water tanks and gutters.



Family funding

Goals

1. To ensure that sponsored children remain in school and goes through all levels of education.
2. To see a society free from illiteracy that contributes to poverty and ignorance.
3. To help families acheive their dreams in life and be able to sustain themselves and their families in future.



Achievements
