Our site works with children and adolescents whose parents perform trades, such as street vendors, sewing assistants, etc. Many parents don't have a basic education or are illiterate. Many youngsters don't have the possibility of continuing with higher education because they are obliged to work to support their families. With support, they're able to continue their studies.



Education

Goals

1. To continue encouraging the literacy process for parents.
2. To develop family violence prevention workshops and refer some specific cases to the nearby health center.
3. To continue workshops to improve the communication between parents and teenage children.

Achievements

1. 100% of our sponsored children and adolescents are studying and have acceptable school performance.
2. There was attention given for children with language problems, learning challenges and social skills who participated in the workshops, the same that were organized by the psychologist.
3. Eight students will begin their professional technical careers.

Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To continue with family violence prevention workshops in coordination with the women's emergency center.
2. To encourage the sponsored children to have regular medical checkups.

Achievements

1. 80% of children are aware of the importance of personal hygiene and health care.
2. The mothers of the family circles accordingly prioritized the purchase of personal hygiene kits.
3. Children received personal hygiene sets in order to prevent the spread of nits.

Nutrition

Goals

1. To ensure the good nutrition of the sponsored children and adolescents through nutrition talks.
2. To carry out nutritional controls and TB screenings, using medical insurance.

Achievements

1. The mothers of the family circles are aware of the importance of children's nutrition and to prioritize the purchase of nutritious foods.
2. The mothers of the family circles perform healthy practices in what concerns to food preparation.
3. 90% of the sponsored children and adolescents have better levels of nutrition.

Community

Goals

1. To encourage the culture of savings within the mothers of the sponsored.
2. To raise awareness through the culture of peace and the care of the environment.

Achievements

1. Five members of the family circles were strengthened in leadership and personal development, and provided support during the family violence prevention talks.
2. Thanks to the prevention workshops on family violence, all mothers recognize their rights and duties, and go to the appropriate places when needing to report cases of abuse.
3. Mothers are aware of the need to create a culture of peace for a healthy communication within the community.

Family

Goals

1. To continue the workshops to improve the role of parents and children within the home.
2. To motivate personal and family savings through planning and budgeting workshops.

Achievements

1. 47 cases of family violence were attended to, the same that were referred to the health center for immediate assistance.
2. The parents of the family circles are trained to start small businesses.
3. Families integrate the pastoral program to confirm a grassroots community.

Family funding

Goals

1. To empower the members of the family circles to have a view towards individual and group savings; this way they can face more urgent needs.
2. To continue with family budget planning talks.



Achievements

1. All parents attend their meetings to make agreements and conduct purchases according to the specific area within the corresponding quarter.
2. The board of each circle directs and enforces the distribution of the sponsorship funds according to the quarter (education, health, nutrition and family) and make their purchases.
3. 98% of mothers have a savings account in the bank. The funds from FF, special money and other amounts are deposited directly into the account of the sponsored child's guardian. Only 2% have not opened a savings account due to illiteracy or bank debt problems.
